Ghost Birds

The new Marshall Ginevan book from Page Turner Press and Media is a short novel titled **Ghost Birds**. It steps away from the serious threats of drug trafficking, terrorists, and police corruption that are found in the *Wrong Side* series. **Ghost Birds** is a mix of science fiction and mystery in an aviation story about military aircraft returning across a timeline from 1943.

Most of the characters in this book are new, but you are not totally unconnected from past Marshall Ginevan novels. Jake Masters was introduced in **The Wrong Side of Service** as Eddie Donevant's law partner in Houston. General "Jungle Jim" Bowder first appeared in **The Wrong Side of Loyalty** when he was President and continued in **The Wrong Side of Service** as a flight instructor at the Air Force Academy. There are plenty of conflicts between characters in this new book and still humor is spread throughout. The conversations and action are realistic and help make this story somewhat believable.

And it is an aviation story. It is about pilots and planes and the aviation environment. Take your seat and take a ride with me in this new and surprising aviation adventure as we travel through the pages of **Ghost Birds**.
