## **The Wrong Side of Service**

The last book in the Wrong Side series is about to be released. The heart of **The Wrong Side of Service** is a murder mystery. But if you have read the other four books in the series, this book will explain what happened to some characters who just disappeared from the previous books and it will tie up some loose ends. It will take you back in story time to the previous books.

In **The Wrong Side of Honor**, you were introduced to Eddie Donevant, a young Air Force fighter pilot in Thailand, who was reassigned to an intelligence position in the Security Police building at Ubon. His intelligence partner is Staff Sergeant Ray Metson, from Security Police. These two find themselves assisting John Slaughter and his team of federal drug agents, who are battling a couple of CIA bad guys moving opium through Thailand to the U.S. While this battle rages, both Cambodia and South Viet Nam are beginning to fall to the Communists. It is a war within a war.

Following **The Wrong Side of Honor**, there is a little known short story about Eddie Donevant. **No POW's Have Ever . . .** brings Donevant back to Ubon after the war in search of POW's that are rumored to be held in Viet Nam. This is must reading for those of you who want to know what our young hero was doing between the **Honor** and the **Badge** books.

In **The Wrong Side of the Badge**, Donevant must depend on his friends to get him out of serious trouble in Texas. Then he is back flying planes as a federal agent and on the hunt for drug dealers and corrupt government officials. John Slaughter and Hank Renwick join Donevant from their adventures together in Thailand. There is plenty of crime fighting action and new characters to meet. But this story runs parallel to another story.

In **The Wrong Side of Justice**, you are introduced to Mike Marshall, who befriends Donevant and is also in serious trouble in Texas. With the help of friends, Marshall joins a drug dealer in Mexico and starts a war with CIA drug traffickers. He also crosses back into Texas to kill corrupt police officers who destroyed his career as a DEA agent, which puts Donevant on the trail of his old friend. This parallel story has plenty of action and many new characters.

In **The Wrong Side of Loyalty**, Eddie Donevant is back as a visiting law professor in Moscow. There he finds himself hunting an international terrorist as a guest of the Russian police. The action brings him to Washington, where he is joined by FBI agent Jack Euland from his Texas days, then takes him into the heart of a Middle East war. Donevant is dragged into a power struggle between the President and factions at the top levels of government in this action-packed adventure.

In **The Wrong Side of Service**, Eddie Donevant is back in Houston working as a lawyer. Fighting to save an innocent man's life seems like the right thing to do. Donevant teams up with John Slaughter once again as they go on the hunt for corrupt government officials. This story has a lot of twists and turns that takes you back to revisit all the previous stories and tells you things that you never thought of from the past.

**Service** is the last in the **Wrong Side** series, but look for Eddie Donevant to make token appearances in future books, along with other characters that you may love – or hate.
